The event is scheduled for 6pm on Monday December 5th, 2016 at Thompson Fine Arts, Inc. located at 2902 Maple Avenue, Dallas, TX 75201.

Taiwanese-Malaysian artist and humanitarian, Poesy 小詩 (little poem) lives in Kuala Lumpur, and has been making heads turn both on a regional and international scale with her creative work.

Poesy is the founder of Helping Angels 善行天使 – a global network of volunteers committed to a movement of compassion based on random acts of kindness – her

mission is to engage volunteerism through designing creative projects to impact society into adopting an art of living, to achieve happiness through actions involving the notion of selflessness.

Poesy has battled with paralysis due to spinal tumors since the age of 17. She learned how to walk again twice, albeit lacking sensations in both her lower limbs.

Poesy Liang 梁小詩 is also a poet, singer-songwriter, jewelry designer and a luxury lifestyle interior designer. She was invited to Dallas to attend the Women That Soar 2016 Awards and to develop an art series around empowering women globally.
